# Equality of Bursary Funding for Social Work Students - Letter Signed by 316 Individuals

We write as a group of over 300 social work students at universities across Scotland, supported by the Social Workers Union, the Scottish Association of Social Workers and 20 social work lecturers.

We have seen first-hand the impact of the cost-of-living crisis on our fellow social work students.

As one student said on social media:

"We ended up needing to use food banks to live, I also had to stop doing some visits/sessions due financial difficulties. As it was too difficult to work while on placement. Having more of a bursary would have taken pressure off basic living needs as well as being able to complete it without any additional difficulties."

Many social work students come from deprived backgrounds. Yet, unlike nurses and paramedics, when social work undergraduates spend nine months on placements in their third and fourth years, there are no bursaries to help them.

This means social work students have to work full-time on a placement, study and work shifts or rely on foodbanks to make ends meet.

#### As another student commented:

"During placement I have had to work two jobs to be able to afford rent, food, travel and other bills. A social work bursary would have let me spend more time focusing on my studies and 120-day placement. Not all students have family who are able to financially support them. A lot of students are also unpaid carers who have caring responsibilities on top of studies and this affects their ability to pick up shifts."

This is unacceptable.

We call on the Scottish Government, SAAS and SSSC to make funding available to provide bursaries to all third and fourth year undergraduate social work students in Scotland. These bursaries should last for the full length of the nine-month placements and funded at parity to those bursaries for nurses and paramedics. There are currently c.983 3rd and 4th year students, which would each require c.GBP7,500 a year making the cost of this policy GBP7.4m. Additional, discretionary, bursaries would be welcome to cover the summer months when social

work students are not on placement, especially for those with care responsibilities. [1]

For post-graduate students, there are bursary funds available. However, they are in desperate need of reform.

Presently, postgraduate students often have to be nominated for funding by their lecturers. This means that often older and wealthier lecturers are in a position to nominate (or not) often younger and poorer students for funding.

This is an untenable situation.

We call on the Scottish Government, SAAS and SSSC to reform funding for postgraduate social work students to ensure objective assessment criteria are used to assess the need for bursaries and that they should be funded adequately. We believe this may need an expansion to the total funding available, but would advise that further analysis is required to make more precise calculations.

Without reform we risk not having enough social workers in the future to meet the statutory roles they play, let alone enabling social workers to help "keep The Promise" to those in need and play a full role in ensuring Scotland is a fairer, safer place to live.

Indeed, with 20% of the social work workforce approaching retirement age and 25% leaving the profession within their first six years of starting, Scotland faces recruitment and retention challenges which this proposal will help address. [2]

We would welcome the opportunity to meet with you to discuss our proposals, other challenges facing students on social work placements and look forward to your response.

With the Scottish Government budget due to be presented to Parliament on 15 December, we hope you will understand the urgency of the issue and request a response by 4th November 2022.
